

(3) Hard Drive Assembly (cont.)

c) Screw the hard drive into the chassis using the mounting holes on the side.

d) Flip over the chassis and tighten screws into the aligned holes.



e) Slide the bracket back into the housing. Affix the bottom screws.


(4) Hard Drive Formatting





(3) Hard Drive Assembly

a) Remove the 4 screws from the bottom of the housing. Slide out the inner bracket.

b) Slide the hard drive onto the SATA connector at a slight angle.
